## LOCATION AND ANGLE FOR HUMANE EUTHANASIA OF LARGE ANIMALS PENETRATING CAPTIVE BOLT GUN

## PENETRATING CAPTIVE BOLT GUN:

Animal movement prior to the shot must be controlled with a gate, halter or snare (swine).

The penetrating captive bolt gun must be **placed** on and perpendicular to the skull.

.025 **Red Cartridges** are effective.



## **Confirmation of insensibility within 30 seconds:**

- 1. Lack of corneal reflex
- 2. Inability to right itself or floppy head
- 3. Lack of pain response

## Confirmation of death within 3 minutes:

- 1. Lack of corneal reflex
- 2. Lack of respiration
- 3. Lack of heartbeat
- 4. Lack of vocalization

If animal is not rendered insensible, use a second shot with a firearm or captive bolt gun.
