<i>Dr. Millenbah will work w/ SPDC to clean up forms and submit</i>	#15 description – refers to concentrations, further on it describes certificates #15 under the educational objectives, make the style of REDC requirements mirror the URR requirements (for ex, the REDC text has ‘students will learn...’; the URR header is underlined). *In the URR concentration, “learn about” is not an 800-level objective *Admission: there are preferred degrees listed for the program, but #16 says any MSU grad student and anyone else via life-long can be admitted. SPDC should determine who and how background will be checked for admission.
