The official Scrapie Tag must be attached to the goat's ear. Tattoos are not accepted as a form of official ID for meat goats. Tagging in the tail web is unacceptable by the USDA and microchips are not an acceptable form of tagging for the Kalamazoo County Fair and Family Festival.

For Registered Animals: Scrapie tags and Tattoo numbers will be checked and must match the tag information that is attached/on this registration in order to get into the barn at fair.

Registered Animals Only: If your goat is registered with an official national association breed registry (American Dairy Goat Association, National Pygmy Goat Association, American Boer Goat Association, etc.), they will have a tattoo. You must have the REGISTRATION PAPERS in your possession – tattoo must match the ID number on the Registration Papers. For specific questions on tagging please refer to the MDARD requirements for fairs and exhibitions at <https://www.michigan.gov/mdard/animals/exhibitions/resources-for-exhibitions> or the Kalamazoo County Youth Fair. Due to the recommendation, from the Michigan State Vet found in the document above, microchips will not be allowed for tagging at the Kalamazoo County Youth Fair.
