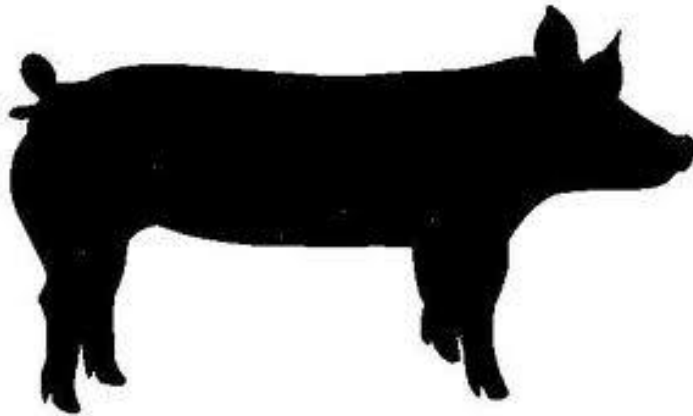

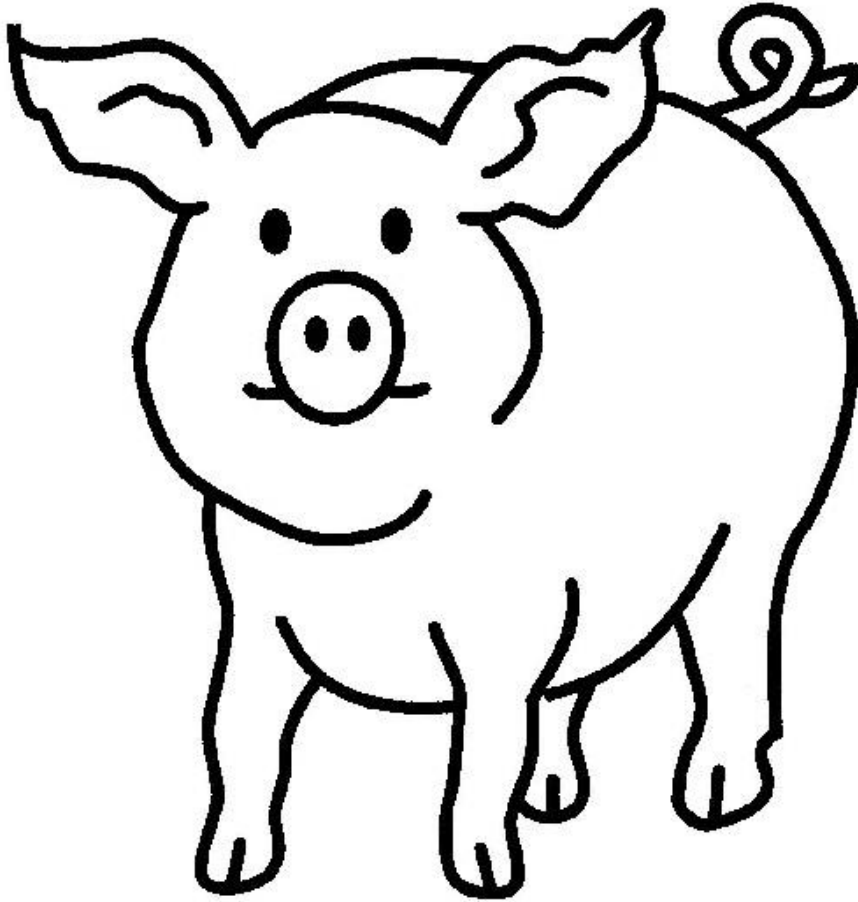
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## PROJECT PLANNING

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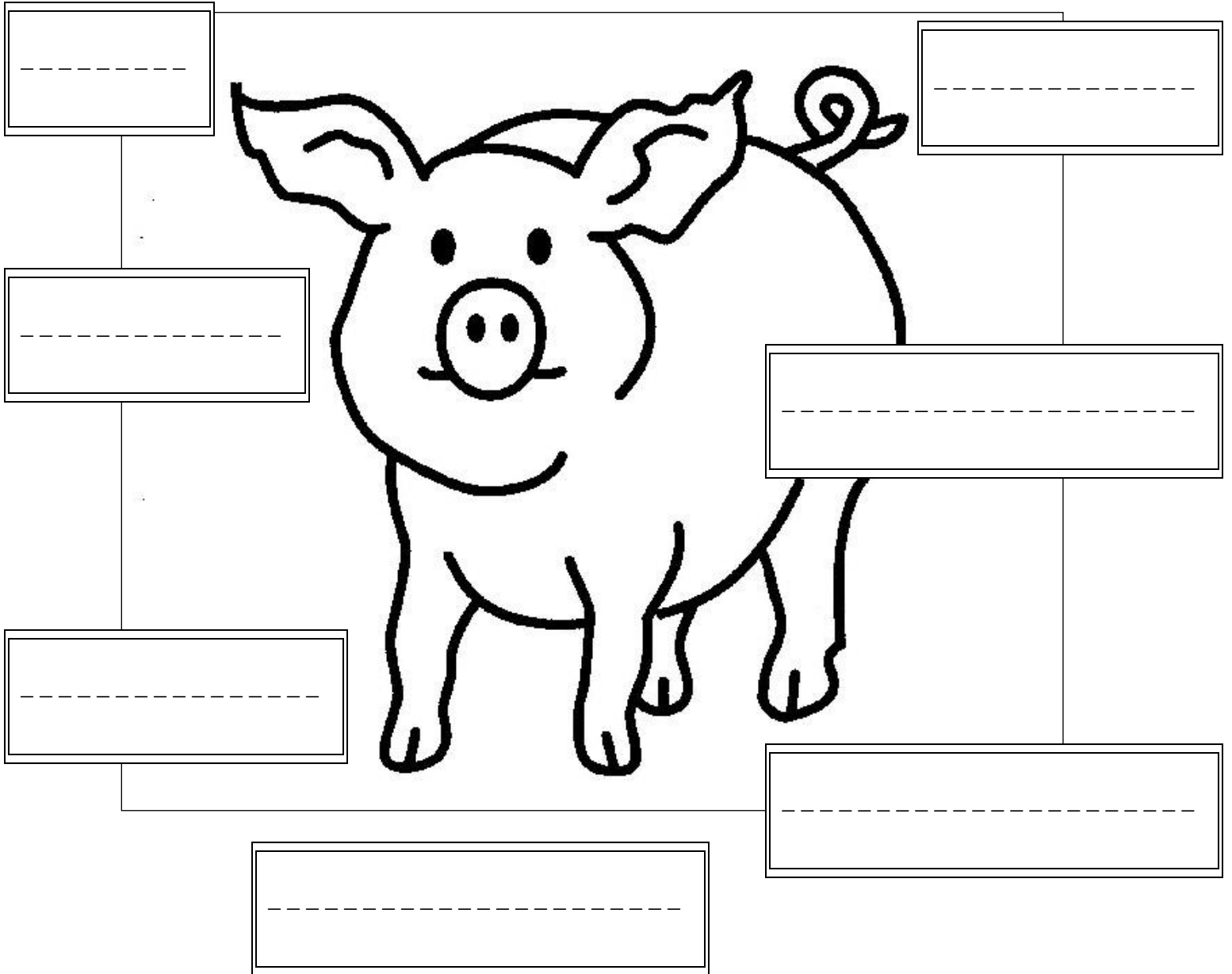

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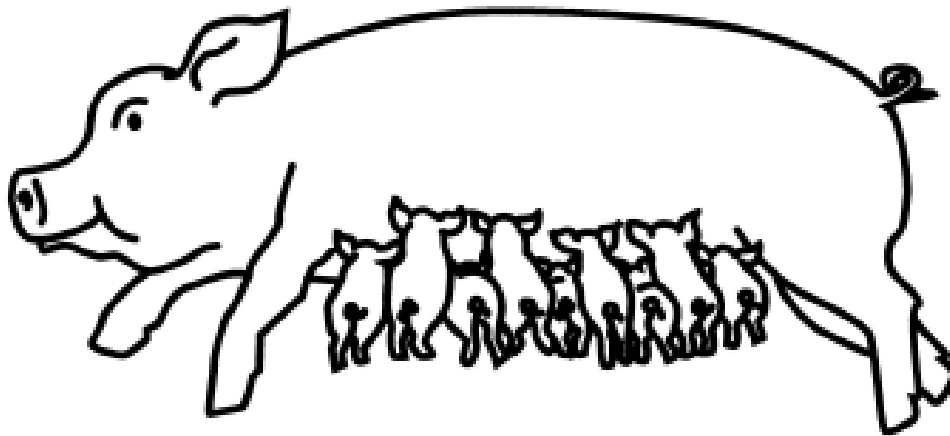
## Parts of the Pig

Sow — Mother pig

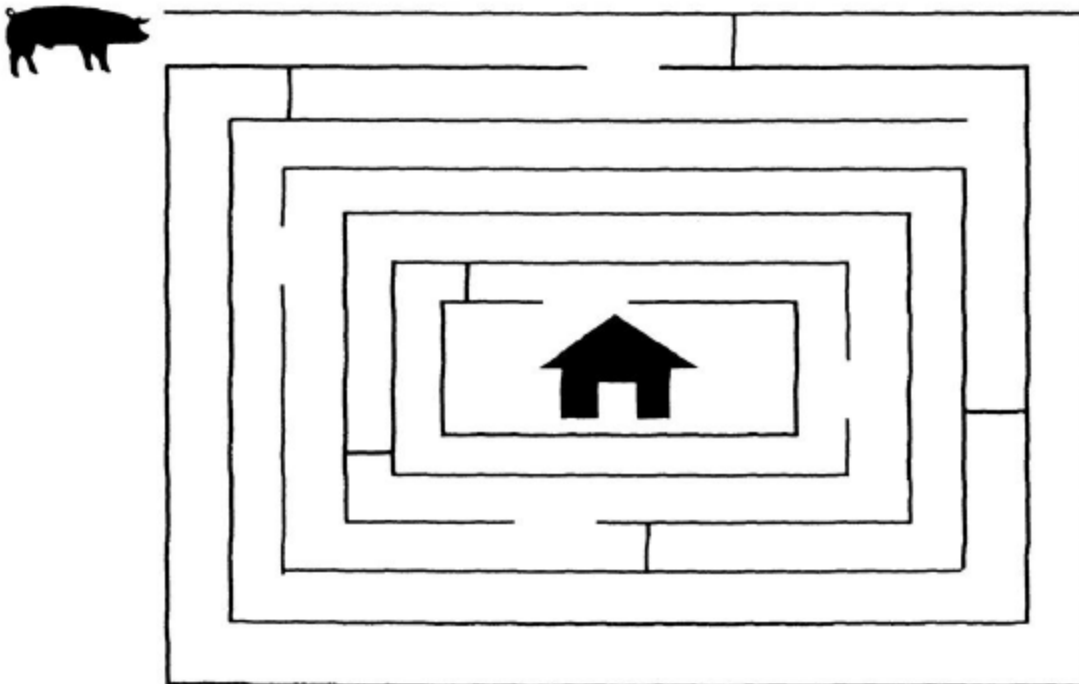
Draw three spots on the sow.

Piglet — Newborn pig

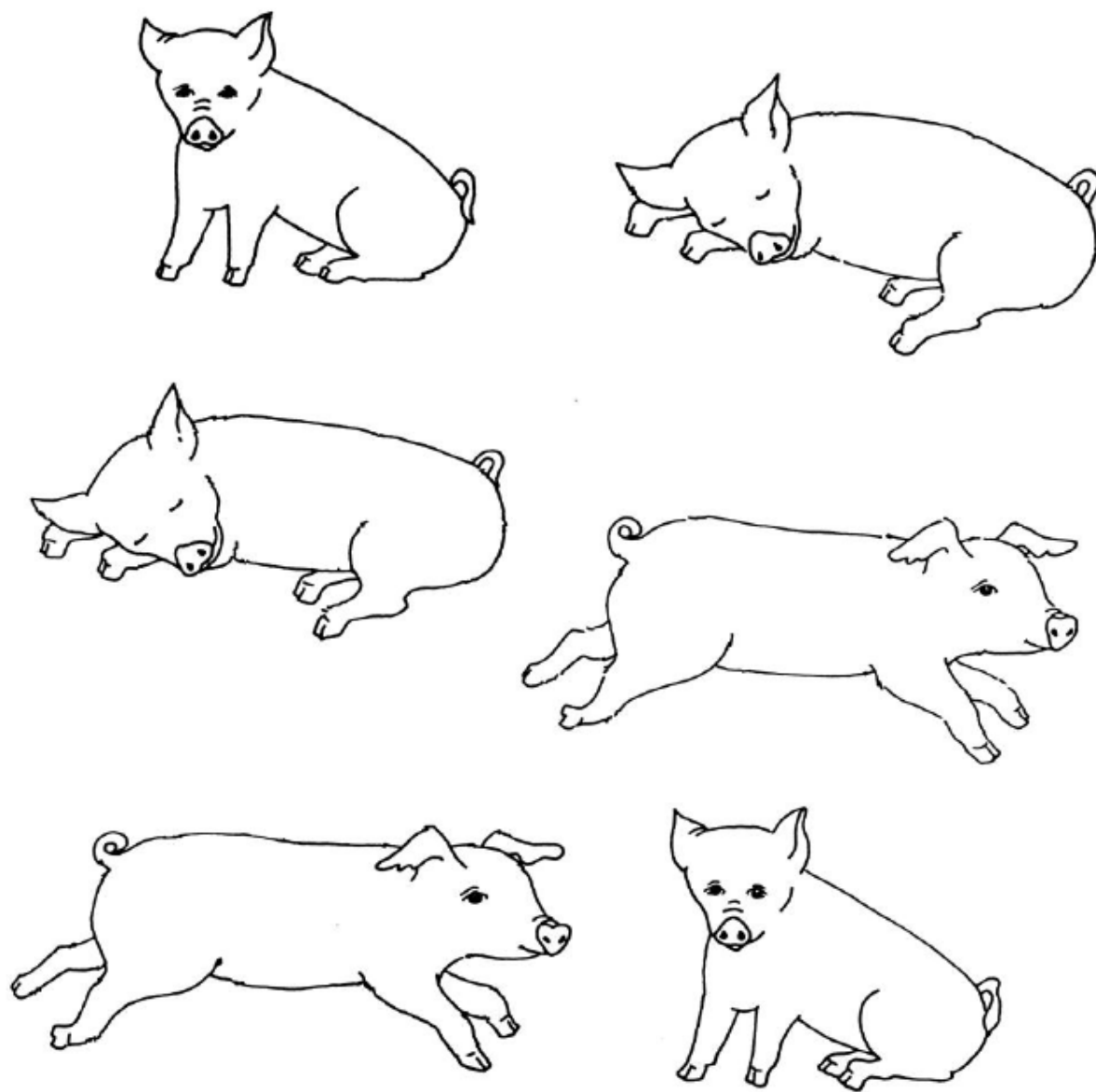
Color one piglet black.

Count the number of piglets in the litter.

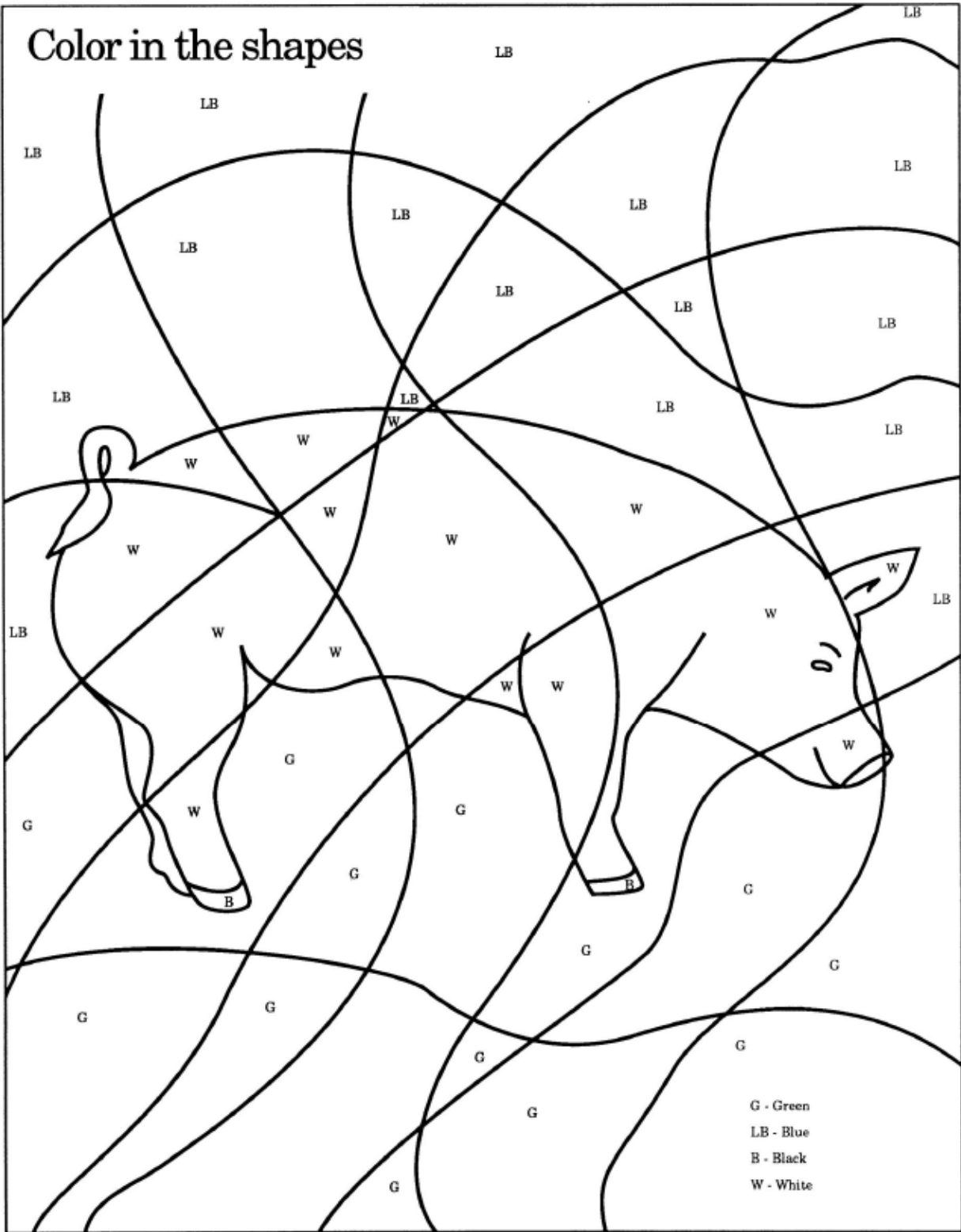


Help the pig find its way to the barn.
