- > IMPORTANT Only use the NEW Shooting Sports project areas.



Quick Search for Shooting Sports Clubs

Shooting Sports Club Search:

- 1. Click the **Participation** tab in the navigation pane.
- 2. Change the Program Year to search.
- 3. Click on the arrow in the **Project** section.
- 4. Scroll through the list of **Projects** selecting *Shooting Sports* and all *Shooting Sports aliases* you may have created.
- 5. Click on Search


Adding NEW Shooting Sports Projects to Clubs

Adding Projects to Clubs:

- 6. Click the **Clubs** tab in the navigation pane.
- 7. Select a **Club** from the list of county clubs.
- 8. Scroll down to the bottom of page to the **Projects** section.
- 9. Click on the **Add** button.
- 10. Scroll through the list of projects, **select each project area** to be added to the Club.
- 11. Select any/and all **Shooting Sports Project** areas that apply.
- 12. Save.

Deleting Projects From Clubs:

- 1. Click on the **Clubs** tab in the navigation pane.
- 2. Select the **Club** that you would like to remove a project from.
- 3. Scroll down to the **Projects** section.
- 4. Select the **Project Name** you want to remove from the club offerings.
- Click the **Delete** button to remove the project from the Club's offerings or click **Cancel** to return to the Club screen.
