To satisfy the dual degree requirements of the BLA/MED degree, students must take a total of 154 total credits. The BLA is 130 credit hours and the MED is 24 credit hours with the potential for nine hours *linked* from the BLA (totaling 33 MED credit hours) as outlined below. The BLA and MED courses must be taken sequentially, because the curriculum is structured along an "integrated course model." Design and creative thought lie at the center of the curriculum and are expressed as a 10-course design studio sequence, which begins in year one. An eight-week Study Abroad experience is integrated into the course sequence in the Spring of year three for which both BLA and dual degree BLA/MED students are eligible. Study Abroad creates a transition point for students to the graduate course work and real world application of knowledge and skills.
