Jackson

From I-94 East bound: Take Exit 138, Turn Left onto 127 S. 127 S turns into West Ave. Turn left onto Andrew Ave. Turn Right onto Lansing Ave.

From I-94 West bound: Take Exit 138 turn Right onto 127 South. 127 South turns into West Ave. street. Turn left onto Andrew Ave. Turn Right onto Lansing Ave.

Howell

From I-96 East bound: Take exit 133. Turn right onto I-96BL E/W Grand River Ave. Once on Grand River Ave, location is approximately 4 miles and will be on your right.

From I-96 West bound: Take exit 141 towards Howell. Turn Left onto Grand River Ave. In 3 miles, the location will be on your left.

Ann Arbor

From I-94 East bound: Take Exit 169 for Zeeb Road. Turn left onto Zeeb Road. In 0.5 miles your destination is on the Left.

From I-94 West bound: Take Exit 169 to N. Zeeb Road. Turn right onto Zeeb Road. In 0.3 miles your destination is on the Left.
