

Training Costs & Enrollment

- A \$50 entry fee covers Level 1 training.
- There is also a \$50 fee for each level 2 and level 3 training up to a maximum of \$300 for each trainee.

Your county 4-H program may cover a portion of this cost, check with your county 4-H staff.

Fees are due two weeks before each training and must be remitted with a training enrollment form.

Fees cover instructional materials, meeting facilities, group equipment costs and mileage for instructors. Each participant is responsible for the cost of his or her own food, personal equipment, and transportation to and from the training sites. Bring your own Personal Flotation Device (PFD) to canoeing and kayaking if you can.
